The Importance of Home Health: In early 19th-century America, care for the sick was part of domestic life guided by family traditions and the advice found in the medical or nursing manuals of the era. For families who were able to afford physicians - health was never a concern. Yet, for those without family or financial resources, few healthcare options were available, that is when they turned to "Assistants" or modern day Nurses.

Nurses who frequently found themselves alone in patient's homes without direct medical oversight simply took charge. Protected by standing orders and nursing procedures endorsed by the local medical group, nurses in the home exercised considerable authority. They saw their role as service to the patient, rather than to the physician. On daily rounds, visiting nurses attended to the patient's environment, nourishment, and medicines. Their patients were women, men, children, mothers and their newborns, school children, workers, the elderly, and the injured.
